Thursday July 28 5-8PM

Check in and **Welcome** event at **Hazlitt 1852 Vineyards**, 5712 State Route 414. Wine and hor d'oeuvres. Smok'n Bones restaurant will be on site with delicious entrees available for those who could not eat dinner before they arrive.

Hazlitt is 9.7 miles north of WalMart in Watkins Glen on St. Rte. 414; 2.3 mi. north of Atwater Estate Vineyards.

Friday July 29 10AM-9PM

Check in at main event at **Atwater Estate Vineyards**, 5055 State Route 414.

Vendors open about 10AM. Wine tasting begins at 11AM. Mo's Barbecue open for meals about 11AM. Jesse Alexander band concert 6-9PM.

Atwater is 7.4 miles north of WalMart in Watkins Glen on St. Rte 414.

Saturday July 30 10AM-5PM

Check in at main event at **Atwater Estate Vineyards**, 5055 State Route 414.

Vendors open about 10AM. Wine tasting begins at 11AM. Mo's Barbecue open for meals about 11AM. Event closes at Atwater about 5PM.

Sunday July 31 11AM

Walk to Taughannock Falls, nine miles north of Ithaca on State Route 89.

Vertical wine tastings of Chardonnay at Kings Garden Vineyards at 11AM and 1PM, 9085 State Route 414, about 7.3 miles north of Hazlitt 1852 Vineyards.

Wine tasting continues at all participating wineries.

Participating Wineries

There are over 40 wineries around Seneca Lake and 16 more on Cayuga Lake.

We have 18 wineries, a brewery and a distillery which have chosen to participate in our event. We hope you will do **all your shopping** at our participating wineries. Otherwise, there is no incentive for new wineries to join our event. As news of our great people and well-mannered hounds spreads, more wineries will wish to join (four new wineries have joined us this year).

Our participating wineries have agreed to

- Accept our wine tickets for wine tasting;
- Allow your greyhounds to stay with you to taste wine or spirits;
- Charge only \$1 for tasting if you have used up all your yellow tickets;

Please patronize our participating wineries, brewery and distillery so that our event continues to grow and provides publicity and funding for area greyhound groups. A **hard card** will be available at our event with a list of wineries and a map.

You should also know that many wineries don't even charge a tasting fee if you purchase a bottle of wine. Always tell the winery that you plan to purchase, and ask about any applicable discounts for larger purchases.

- **Two Goats Brewery** welcomes us for the first year. Greyhounds are not allowed inside the brewery due to NY beer laws (different than laws regulating farm wineries). Greyhounds may be left next door at host Atwater Estate Vineyards in greyhound babysitting area or brought up the back stairs outside on the deck of Two Goats. No ticket needed. You get a free tasting experience with the purchase of one beer. You may walk easily from Atwater Estate to Two Goats.

Wine Tasting Tickets

Your \$25 event ticket entitles you to seven wine tasting tickets to use at seven wineries, including our two host wineries and your choice of five additional wineries/distillery on our list of participating wineries. All wineries will charge \$1 or less for additional tastings.

Thursday evening 5-8 PM ***Welcome Event at Hazlitt 1852 Vineyards*** *(Directions p. 16)*

Once again, Hazlitt is welcoming us to their beautiful winery for welcome festivities. We plan to have wine tasting and hor d'oeuvres outside in the Tiki bar area at Hazlitt from 5-8 PM. This is a lovely location with shade, picnic tables, lawns and seating.

For those who did not have a chance to eat dinner, we will have Smok'n Bones on site with dinner entrees for purchase including some vegan/vegetarian options. [\(See menu, p. 14.\)](#) We wanted to offer this option to purchase dinner so that those who were really hungry did not have to try to fill up on snacks. We think you will like the options – including salads and vegetarian items -- provided by Smok'n Bones.

Hazlitt will provide free hor d'oeuvres, as well as sell wine by the glass, beer and other drinks as desired since their Tiki bar is a full service bar. This is the only winery on our tour that sells beer. Hazlitt has a wonderful selection of delicious wines. We hope that if you find a wine at Hazlitt that you like that you will buy a bottle and thank them for all their support for Grapehounds.

Vendor Tents We will have a large 100' long vendor tent at Atwater for your shopping convenience. Shop in "indoor" comfort during a sudden shower or in shade from the summer sun.

Porta-potties We have the Atwater rest room inside the winery and two outdoor porta-potties for the use of our guests. We will have a hand-sanitizing station in each porta-potty as well.

Cool Hounds

Please watch your hounds for signs of overheating. To cool our hounds we have set up...

Dog Pools We will have a swimming pool for cooling off hounds in the common area at Atwater. We will also have a pool in the doggie babysitting area.

Mister We have dog "mister" to spray a cooling mist in the air for hounds who want a spritz.

Spay Bottle Due to the hotter weather, please consider bringing a spray bottle to cool your hound as needed. Plan to use our shade tents and use shade trees and patios along with air conditioned areas at wineries to stay cool.

Water We will have water dishes around the grounds. Provide your dog an opportunity to drink every chance you get. They will appreciate it.

Food at Atwater Estate All day Friday and Saturday **Mo's Barbecue** – a popular restaurant from Auburn, NY -- will have entrees and sides for us for lunch and dinner both days. They have some vegetarian options such as veggie chili and veggie burgers as well. We think you'll love their food! ([See their menu, p. 15](#))

Bring lawn chairs and a blanket for your hounds. There will be lots of places to sit and relax.

Shade and Eating Tent We are providing an activities tent with tables near the Mo's Barbecue concession where you may sit and eat with your hounds in your lawn chairs or on a blanket. Part of the tent will be stocked with tables, and part shaded lawn for you and your hounds. The music stage will be nearby.

Jesse Alexander Band in Concert Friday Evening 6-9PM

We plan a great Bluegrass concert on Friday evening 6-9 PM at our host Atwater Estate Vineyards under the stars for your enjoyment. *Bring your lawn chairs and a blanket for the hounds.* Your admission is included with your wine tasting ticket.

The Jesse Alexander band is a local fixture in the Finger Lakes and in fact they host a national Bluegrass festival every August called **Pickin' in the Pasture** on the Alexander's farm nearby. The winery will be selling wine by the bottle and by the glass and doing wine tastings during the concert. Mo's Barbecue will be selling dinner entrees and sides.

There is a \$3 charge for the concert for those who did not purchase a Grapehound Wine Tour wine tasting ticket. Your Grapehounds wine glass is your free admission ticket!

Saturday Music

Cindy McConnell of Reston, Virginia will be back on our stage to play acoustic guitar and sing from 1PM Friday Saturday afternoon until about 4PM. Cindy is not only a greyt musician but a proud greyhound owner!

We plan to have a large grassy area near the stage and eating tent area where folks can pitch a blanket or set up their lawn chairs, sip some wine, and enjoy the music with their hounds.

Wine Sales

In additional to your free wine tasting at Atwater, the winery will sell wine by the glass or wine by the bottle throughout the weekend. Hang out with us and enjoy the food, vendors and music.

Greyhound Babysitting Go shop and taste some wine!

Once again the great folks at **Forever Home Greyhound Adoption** (Middleburgh, NY) will be attending to your hounds while you shop or taste wine using a double-gated, four-foot high plastic coated wire fence enclosure. Their staff actually sits inside with the greyhounds to make sure everyone is safe. They will tag your dog with your name and cell phone number in case they need to reach you. **Bring your muzzles**, as all dogs must be muzzled in the babysitting area. (Some extras will be on hand so don't worry if you forgot yours...)

There is a swimming pool, water dishes and a large 20 x 30 tent inside the babysitting area for shade to keep your pups cool and comfortable in that wonderful breeze off the lake.

Dog Wash

Forever Home will also wash and dry your dog for you this year so he/she smells like a new pup.

You may leave your pup with confidence that they will be spoiled, comfortable and safe while you are gone. Go enjoy some wine!

Silent Auction Ends Saturday 4PM

Ro Narbe and the good folks at Finger Lakes Adopt A Grey (FLAAG) have been working tirelessly to assemble some fantastic baskets and items for our silent auction. New Stuff

Here are new things for this year...

- We will have Smok'n Bones offering dinner entrees at the Welcome event at Hazlitt 1852 Vineyards for those who did not get dinner before they came. Don't worry about supper; just come right to the welcome event and Smok'n Bones will hook you up!
- We will have a dog wash option at the greyhound babysitting area.
- We have a Friday evening concert with the Jesse Alexander Band.
- We have five new wineries and a brewery this year, including Red Tail Ridge Winery, Fulkerson Winery, and Fruit Yard Winery on the west side of the lake, JR Dill Winery, the Hector Wine Company, and Two Goats Brewery on the east side.
- We have a vertical Chardonnay wine tasting (tasting several varieties of the same type of wine) on Sunday at 11AM and 1PM at Kings Garden Vineyards.

Be Sure to Bring...

Lawn Chairs We will have plenty of opportunity to sit and hang out this weekend with wine, music, vendors and greyhounds. Please bring lawn chairs in case the grass is wet from a shower or dew.

Blanket, Sheet, Quilt Please bring a quilt or blanket for your hounds to lay on the grass with you during the concert or just to take a break. If you allow hounds on your bed, please bring a sheet or cover to protect the hotel's bed covering.

Dog Pillows Bring your dog's pillow to make him or her feel at home in new surroundings.

Rain Gear I have always found that if you are prepared for rain, it doesn't happen. Let's try it again!

Spray Bottle if we get a warm afternoon, bring a mist-er or spray bottle to cool off your hound(s).

Water Bring a dish and water for your hounds. Water dishes will be available at many wineries.

ID Tags Make sure your hound has an ID tag with your name and address information and cell phone number. Use a temporary tag if you do not have a more permanent ID.

Old Towels Handy for wiping your hound's feet after a rainstorm creates some mud or wet feet in the morning dew.

Poop Bags Bring some extra bags to be good guests at our hotels and cabins.

Flashlight Bring a flashlight for those late night or early morning potty walks.

Water If your hounds react badly to new water, bring some water from home for their water dish.

Red Bandana Required for any dog which has aggression issues or does not react well in close quarters with hounds or humans. Use the red bandana to let us know to keep away. You are responsible for your hound's behavior. Remove him/her from stressful surroundings.

Leashes Dogs must be leashed at all times at wineries and hotels during our weekend.

Muzzles Handy to have. Required for doggie babysitting area (though they have extras if you forget).

Flea-Tick Preventative Make sure your hounds are protected. Humans may wish to bring some **Off** or insect repellent in case bugs are a problem at the outdoor venues.

Rabies and Vaccination Certificates Required to camp in NY state parks. Not required for any of our other activities, nor for our walk to Taughannock Falls on Sunday.

Weather We have an emergency weather radio on site and will warn participants should threatening weather approach.

Handicapped Parking We will help any handicapped parties to access parking close to the event. Just let us know at the registration table how we can help.

Ambassadors This year we have made a special effort to get local people to come out, join us and meet the greyhounds. Please be ambassadors for greyhound adoption and answer questions posed by people who are new to greyhounds. One of our goals is to raise greyhound awareness among the local community so that more adoptions are possible.

Tip: Warm Weather If the afternoon gets warm, go taste wine in one of the large, airconditioned tasting rooms along Route 414. Damiani, Finger Lakes Distilling, JR Dill, Pompous Ass, Silver Springs, and Hazlitt are great places to hang out.

Other Helpful Information

Hector Fair

The Hector Fair (a local carnival event with rides and games) is located on St. Rte. 414 the same weekend as our event just a block north of Hazlitts 1852 Vineyards. There may be slow traffic at times in this area, especially Friday evening during the parade.

The Italian Festival in Watkins Glen

Last year some of our folks got caught up in parade traffic at the Italian Festival in Watkins Glen and could not get around to the other side of the lake. We are happy to report that the Italian Festival will be held later this year -- in August -- and will not influence our event at all.

Your registration information contains a hard-card map of participating wineries and major roads around Watkins Glen. It also contains a full map of the Finger Lakes region.

WalMart

There is a WalMart in Watkins Glen, 7.4 miles south of Atwater Estate and a little over 9.7 miles south of Hazlitt 1852 Vineyards. If you have need of something you left at home, WalMart may be the answer.

Stone Cat Restaurant

Stone Cat is on St. Rte. 414 near the wineries (about 1.2 miles north of Atwater). People with dogs may eat there if their dogs stay next to the deck. We have asked them to allow dogs on the deck but so far they have not permitted this.

No Dogs Left in Cars, Please

Please do not leave your dog(s) in your car in summer under any circumstances. Cars with the windows rolled down can still heat up to over 100 degrees in minutes. We will attempt to find the owners of dogs left in cars and then we will call the local authorities to get the dogs out of the car.

Ice Cream Social 3:30 PM Saturday

The Ice Cream Social is time to meet and hang out with friends and greyhounds. It is sponsored by Allison and Jeff Truelsen and **Gorges Greyhounds** of Ithaca. Vanilla frozen yogurt is provided free for all hounds; humans may also buy ice cream for themselves. This year, ice cream will be available all weekend! All proceeds go directly to **Gorges Greyhounds** of Ithaca, NY.

From Seneca Falls

Follow St. Rte. 414 *south* from Seneca Falls approximately 29 miles to **Hazlitt 1852 Vineyards** (*on left*) and another 2.3 miles to **Atwater estate Vineyards** (*on right*).

From Ithaca

Follow State Route 79 west out of Ithaca about 18 miles to the town of Burdett.

As you come into the Village of Burdett on Route 79 (30 mph zone)-- after the Dandy Mart on the right -- you'll come to a four-way stop with a flashing red light ("The Old H&E" bar is on the left corner ahead of you). Go straight through the intersection onto **Lake Avenue** (leaving Rte. 79). Go 1/10 mile to a four-way stop and turn right onto **Main Street/County Road 5**. Continue on this road for just over one mile to **Route 414**. Turn right onto Route 414 and go 3.2 miles to **Atwater Estate Vineyards** (*on left*).

Continue north past Atwater Estate on State Route 414 2.3 miles to **Hazlitt 1852 Vineyards**.

From Ithaca

1. Follow route 89 north about 18 miles to County Road 141/Kraft Road.
